



Our Street Legal Side by Sides start with a Right Turn out of our Driveway (JHAR) and head towards town square on W. Broadway St (191). After passing the town square you will be on E. Broadway Street which dead ends at Elk Refuge Rd. At Elk Refuge Road you will make a left turn. After passing the Miller House and Millers Butte on your left-hand side you will make a 90-degree left at Point (A). After passing a few ranches on your right-hand side you come to intersection (B). If you make a right turn here, you will head up Curtis Canyon. As a suggestion I like to do Flat Creek first and come back to Curtis Canyon. I would stay straight at the (B) intersection and head towards Flat Creek. It will be a smooth Gravel Road until you reach (C) Here the road will turn more into an off-road trail system weaving you side by side with Flat creek. The Sleeping Indian Rock formation will be straight ahead of you. The trail dead ends at Flat Creek ranch. Please do not go through the gate as this is private property. Head Back the same way you came in to intersection (B). Curtis Canyon is a full twisting hill climb. Please be aware that people camp from the bottom all the way to the top! There will be other people on the road! The top of Curtis is marked with letter (D). To reach the top of Curtis you will need to make sure you take the left hand turn at 30445. At Point D you will be in a large open field with expansive views of the valley. You have time to complete both Flat Creek and Curtis Canyon in you half day Side by Side Adventure! For the Morning 1/2 day make sure you are back in the town of Jackson by 12 in order to get Gas and be back to the shop by 12:30. For the Afternoon 1/2 day make sure you are back in town by 4:30 in order to get Gas and be back at the shop by 5pm. Ride Safe and be Backcountry Aware
